

FUNDING

- KHEAA Dual Credit Scholarship
 - All students in grades 11 and 12 are eligible
 - o 2 per year = 4 total = 12 hours
- KHEAA Work Ready Scholarship (CTE Courses only)
 - All students in grades 9-12 are eligible
 - o 2 per year
- Community Partnerships



100% of our students who have taken a dual credit course have not paid anything out of pocket.

Funding Support

- 10th Grade Classes
 - History 102
 - No funding in place
 - o 65 students (\$20k)
- Juniors & Seniors who have exhausted their 6 hour scholarships
 - o Class 3, 4, etc.
 - No funding in place
 - Approximately \$20k
