WHSAA Announces Sophomore Scholars Program

Responding to shifting needs for Academic Support and the desire of the Association to financially assist as many students as possible, WHSAA announces the *Sophomore Scholars Program*. This answers the principal's request to provide for the unmet **financial** need in the CollegeNow 'Dual Credit' program for the **ENTIRE sophomore class** at WHS.

College Now - Dual Credit Program

Unique to WHS, CollegeNow offers Academy students in grades 9-12 the opportunity to take college courses from 6 statewide colleges.

Details [here](#) - but some highlights:

- 9th - 1 hr class, 10th - 3 hr class
- 11th, 12th - 17 classes split among the respective Academy
- 422 classes taken in 2024/5
- 92% pass rate
- 6 participating colleges
- individualized college prep tools provided
- higher college application rates

Why We're 100% Behind This Program

The Alumni Association is following the lead of other support organizations to broaden their impact on student academic success. WHSAA Scholarships assist and recognize certain graduating seniors, while this new program supports the entire sophomore class with current studies. In addition:

- value - colleges charge \$97 / credit hour compared to \$189 - \$553 normally
- breadth - ~60 students benefit compared to 4-5 scholarships
- specific need - the sophomore class did not have a funding source

How Can You Help?

Alumni have always been extremely generous in support of scholarships - and we ask that you continue to be as supportive for this new academic support channel. Our *goal* is to support 100% of the ongoing unmet need (~\$18,000 / year) for the sophomore class, and the Board approved \$10,000 immediately. **Your help** is needed for us to reach this goal.
