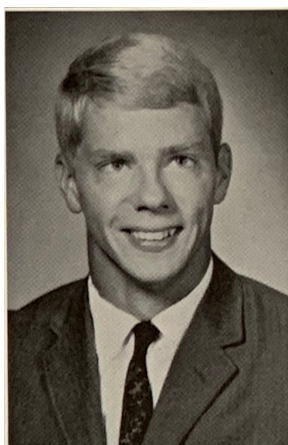
**2026 Waggener Hall of Fame Inductees Announced!**

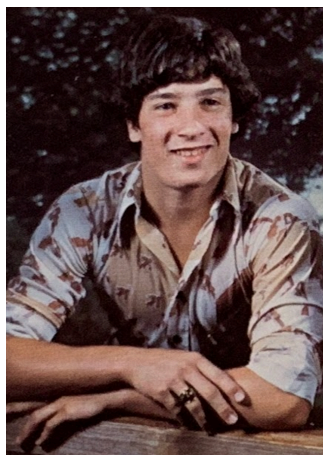
